Apply to Nomen Global

Prepare the following documents. Send them to Nomen Global by email, fax, or mail.

- Student Application
- Application and Express Mail Fees
- Copy of Passport
- Copy of Bank Statement
- Statement of Sponsor Support

*We use these documents to create your I-20. We will process and send your I-20 within two weeks. Use your I-20 to apply for your student visa.*

<p>A student visa may be issued 120 days or fewer before the start date indicated on the I-20.</p> <p>To qualify for a visa, the student must</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have a residence abroad, with no immediate intention of abandoning that residence.</li> <li>• Intend to depart from the United States upon completion of the course of study.</li> <li>• Possess sufficient funds to pursue the proposed course of study.</li> </ul>	<p>Contact Nomen Global to let them know you received your I-20.</p> <p>Check to make sure the information on the I-20 is correct.</p> <p>Sign both copies of the I-20.</p> <p>Learn about specific embassy instructions at the <a href="#">Embassy and Consulate website</a>.</p> <p>Schedule your visa interview.</p> <p>Complete the DS-160 Form.</p> <p>Pay the MRV Fee and the SEVIS Fee.</p>	<p>I-20 Form</p> <p>DS-160 Form – Online Non-immigration Visa Electronic Application</p> <p>Passport</p> <p>One (1) 2x2 photograph</p> <p>MRV Fee receipt (Visa application fee)</p> <p>SEVIS I-901 Fee receipt</p> <p>Original Statement of Sponsor Support</p> <p>Original Financial Documents</p> <p>Any transcripts or diplomas</p>	<p>Contact Nomen Global to report the result of the interview.</p> <p>If you are APPROVED – continue to the next step.</p> <p>If you are DENIED – you may apply for another visa with a renewed I-20.</p>

Arrange Housing

Decide which of the following housing options is best for you.

Pay Homestay Location Fee or Apartment Location Fee (if applicable).			
Contact Nomen Global to let them know your plans.			

Make Travel Plans

Remember the following guidelines as you make travel plans.

- Purchase tickets and make travel plans **only after** the visa is issued.
- The Department of Homeland Security requires that students enter the U.S. 30 days or fewer prior to the start date of classes (indicated on the I-20).
- Buy roundtrip plane tickets to arrive and depart from the Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC).

Prepare to Depart

Be sure to prepare **well** for international travel.

Plan to arrive early to Utah to do the following:	Bring the following:
Get accustomed to life in the U.S.	I-20
Take placement exams	Other original documents
Register for classes	Passport
Move into Homestay family's home, apartment, or hotel	Emergency cash (about \$250)
